



SCHOLARSHIPS GUIDELINES

South Coast Conservatory will award a limited number of scholarships, based on the availability of institutional and private funds, to eligible students. The scholarships may range from \$1,500-\$4,000 per year (Sept.-June)

Scholarships are provided to assist deserving students; however, students with demonstrated need will also be considered. All South Coast Conservatory Scholarships are designed to aid in the training of the dancer. With this in mind, all students accepted into the Scholarship Program will have their class schedule set by the Scholarship Board and/or the staff of South Coast Conservatory.

I. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Recipients of the scholarship are required to:

- A. Must be currently enrolled or able to enroll immediately at South Coast Conservatory
- B. Enrolled for or able to enroll in 2-12 hours week depending on scholarship criteria.
- C. Have and maintain a satisfactory GPA (2.00-4.00) if applicable.
- D. Be at the appropriate age for the scholarship you are applying
- E. Enrolled in our EA or Accel Program **OR** be willing to have your dance schedule set by the Scholarship Board

II. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- A. Complete and submit the Scholarship Application with the items listed below.
- B. Submit a letter of reference from someone you are not related to (teacher, guidance counselor, employer)
- C. One page essay about yourself explaining your family background, personal interest, what you plan to study and why you want to further your dance education.

III. SELECTION RECIPIENTS

Selections will be based on student's overall progress, financial need, extracurricular activities, leadership skills, future plans in the entertainment industry, and participation in outside activities.

IV. NOTICE OF AWARDS

Scholarship recipients are usually announced by our annual studio recital but all recipients receive notice by e mail. . Notice is sent for award, not always denial.

V. RENEWAL OF SCHOLARSHIP

If this application is a renewal please attach a separate sheet describing how the scholarship benefited you and why it should be renewed in lieu of the one page essay for new applicants.

VI. REVOCATION OF AID

South Coast Conservatory reserves the right to cancel any scholarship awarded at any time if the applicant fails to meet the scholarship requirements, or falsifies information reported.



South Coast Conservatory Scholarships

South Coast Conservatory different types of scholarships available to help you meet your dance goals.

We offer:

- 1. A Work Study Scholarship** (ages 16+) approximate value \$1,500 offering a trade on tuition for completing tasks here at the studio or in our local community.
- 2. A TA Scholarship** (ages 13+) approximate value \$1,500 offering a trade on tuition for assisting teachers and productions here at the studio. This scholarship includes pedagogy so that participants can later receive jobs teaching, choreographing and directing.
- 3. A Boys Ballet Scholarship** (ages 5+) approximate value \$600- \$1,800 offering a trade on tuition for non classical dance classes for participation in our Ballet Classes and Performances. Up to eight per year.

Scholarships are open to current students and those wishing to attend our Conservatory. If you are not currently enrolled, a movement audition submitted by video or in person maybe required in addition to your application.

You can pick up applications at the front desk. Applications must be turned into the front desk by June 1st to be considered.
